

## **SUMMER SCHOOLS BEHAVIOUR POLICY**

*We welcome guests, but ask that they respect the quiet learning environment around them as the College continues academic activity throughout the year. To help ensure this we have established some essential behaviour guidelines for visiting student groups.*

### **GUIDELINES FOR VISITING STUDENT GROUPS**

#### **DO'S**

- Take notice of the fire action plans that are clearly displayed in the rooms and familiarise yourself with this information.
- Behave with courtesy and respect to other guests and College Members at all times.
- Purchase food from the Buttery Café where there are lots of good choices available.
- Treat College property with care, as any damages must be paid for.
- Dispose of litter either in the bins provided in public areas or in the bedrooms. Litter should not be left in gardens or outside areas.
- Adhere to the College Smoking Policy and only smoke/vape in designated areas.
- Keep your bedroom clean and in good order. Any damages to the rooms will need to be paid for.
- Keep the noise levels down between 10.00pm and 9.00am especially and keep to reasonable levels at all other times to avoid disrupting other guests.

#### **DONT'S**

- Drink alcohol, smoke or use a vapour anywhere in College and especially in the bedrooms.
- Shout or make loud noises in and around the College.
- Play ball (or other) games only in the designated areas.
- Play loud music in the bedrooms.
- Go near any restricted areas, including areas that are being refurbished.
- Lose your key! If keys are lost, there is a charge of £40.00 per key to replace them.
- Use the student kitchens
- Order off site take away food for consumption in College.
- Cause wilful damage, or behave disruptively, as you will be asked to leave the College immediately.
- Tamper with the fire-fighting equipment or set off the fire alarms other than in an emergency.
